#### Informational Updates

### 1. Winter Storm Elliott PAI Settlement Agreement

On December 19, 2023, FERC <u>approved</u> a settlement package between PJM and 81 other settling parties regarding non-performance charges assessed by PJM during <u>Winter Storm Elliott</u>.

Please review the following materials regarding the settlement approval and impacts:

<u>FERC Settlement FAQ</u> – this document contains answers to several billing and credit/collateral related questions and provides processing timeline information.

<u>Settlement Reduced Non-Performance Assessment Charges and Credits</u> – this spreadsheet contains an estimate of the reduced non-performance charges and bonus credits for the event under the terms of the Settlement Agreement.

PJM will implement the Settlement Agreement updates and also complete the 3 months of PAI billing that were suspended per the waiver in FERC Docket No. EL23-53, et al. in the February 2024 monthly billing statement.

Additional details regarding the implementation of the Winter Storm Elliot Settlement Agreement will be discussed at the February 29, 2024 <u>Risk Management Committee</u> meeting.
