Markets Related Governing Documents Issue Tracking

Issue Status

The Harmonizing Provisions of Governing Documents Problem Statement was brought forward by PJM, first read at the November 20, 2014 MRC, and approved with its issue charge at the December 18, 2014 MRC. At the July 23, 2015 Markets and Reliability Committee the Tariff Harmonization Senior Task Force was converted to a subcommittee and will now be known as "The Governing Document Enhancement and Clarification subcommittee" (GDECS). Its mission is to address inconsistencies, and any confusing, ambiguous and inaccurate provisions in PJM's governing documents.

Target Completion

Indefinite due to subcommittee status

Progress Update

For the October 22, 2015 GDECS meeting the PJM legal department presented corrections and clarifications, both substantive and non-substantive to previously identified governing agreements provisions. This initiative is to bring accuracy and better understanding of market rules.

PJM attorneys also re-open the topic of Alternative Dispute Resolution for discussion. A poll will be administered to gauge consensus on the topic prior to the October 23, 2015 GDECS meeting. A possible first read will occur at the November 19, 2015 Markets and Reliability Committee.
