



Fuel Security Sr. Task Force Monthly Progress Report

April 19, 2019

Valuing Fuel Security

Issue Status

The group is currently in the education phase of the Consensus Based Issue Resolution Process.

Target Completion

By the end of the third quarter 2019 the group will complete key work activities #1 - #4, and expected deliverable #1, and will report to the MRC their recommendations. The remainder of the key work activities and deliverables will be completed by the deadline to be set by the MRC at the September 2019 meeting.

Progress Update

The group has held six meetings to date: April 5, April 26, May 17, June 26, July 16, and August 12 and has its next meeting scheduled for September 20.

At the August 12 meeting, PJM asked stakeholders if they would be agreeable to moving the deadline to make a recommendation to the Markets & Reliability Committee (MRC) for deliverable #1 from September to December. The delay would allow PJM staff more time to complete the required analysis to make a meaningful recommendation to the MRC. The FSSTF agreed with this change. Tim Horger will ask for endorsement of this change in the timeline at the August 22 MRC meeting.

Action Requested (if necessary)

An update on the activities of the FSSTF and endorsement of a delay of stakeholder recommendation on the path forward will be on the August 22 MRC agenda.
