 PJM staff reviewed directives within FERC order 2222 that require close coordination with distribution utilities. PJM Staff also engaged EDCs via questions regarding utility review and operational coordination on FERC order 2222.



 PJM staff introduced few potential solution to certain aspects of FERC order no. 2222 while seeking stakeholder feedback on initial PJM position on topics such as interconnection, size requirements, locational requirements, and the opt-in process for small utilities.
