

OC/MIC Special Sessions: Fuel Requirements for Black Start Resources

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Considering additional fuel assurance requirements, for new and existing black start resources, to ensure the black start fleet can be fuel assured beyond their primary fuel source, in the event the primary fuel source is unavailable.

- July, 2018 Problem Statement and Issue Charge approved by MRC
 - Assignment Dual OC and MIC
- January, 2019 Work started
- 13 special sessions
- January 7-17, 2020 Poll on packages
- March 11, 2020 Cancelled OC/MIC vote on packages



- Continued work offline with stakeholders to refine proposals
- Adjusted cost estimates to reflect updated/new proposals
- Received OPSI letter on 2/13
- PJM evaluated OPSI concerns
- Reviewed updated packages and proposed next steps with special session on 3/2



- PJM recommending 4-8 month hiatus to perform additional analysis, such as:
 - Additional restoration impact analysis, expanding on previous incremental increase in restoration time analysis
 - Correlation of potential gas pipeline issues impacting restoration process
 - Cost analysis / economic impact
