

## EMS TELEMETRY PROTECTIONS

### *Issue Source*

Initiated by PJM.

### *Issue Content*

PJM has identified the opportunity to bring greater clarity to Manual 01 Section 3.2.4.1, addressing SCADA failure modes, and Attachment E, addressing PJM's "View-Only Mode."

### *Key Work Activities and Scope*

1. Review opportunity for greater clarity of PJM's alternate communication method that can be used as a backup for a wide variety of large-scale SCADA failure modes.
2. Review opportunity for greater clarity of PJM's "View-Only Mode" that allows PJM to negate incoming links during windows of planned maintenance, where risks of incorrect data are elevated.
3. Review proposed Manual 01 revisions addressing greater clarity surrounding these provisions in Manual 01 Section 3.2.4.1, Requirements for Electronic Alternate Data Communication Method and Attachment E, Reliability Guidelines to Mitigate the Unplanned Loss of EMS Real Time Assessment (RTA) Capabilities.

### *Expected Deliverables*

Proposed revisions to Manual 01 Section 3.2.4.1, Requirements for Electronic Alternate Data Communication Method and Attachment E, Reliability Guidelines to Mitigate the Unplanned Loss of EMS Real Time Assessment (RTA) Capabilities.
