Load Forecast Update

PJM is proposing some changes to the load forecast model that were discussed at the LAS meeting of Aug. 6. For more information, please refer to the material that was posted for the Aug. 6 LAS meeting. PJM will review the proposed changes with the PC in September and then draft Manual language changes that will be reviewed through the stakeholder process up to the MRC. Any model changes would become effective with the 2020 Load Forecast Report to be issued in late Dec/early Jan 2020.

Special Session of the Planning Committee on Merchant Transmission and Offshore Wind

At the most recent meeting on June 15, PJM presented additional details on, along with examples, for the previously proposed PJM solution options. Following the meeting PJM released a poll to determine stakeholder preferences regarding: the temporary "XCIR" concept; possible changes to the generation request process; study and analysis requirements; as well as support for the existing three solution packages.
