Purpose

The purpose of the Biennial Review is to conduct a joint review of the processes and procedures used to implement the Joint Operating Agreement (JOA) between PJM and MISO

The Biennial Review

- Original Baseline occurred in 2012
 - Settlement agreement between PJM & MISO signed in January of 2011
 - Utilicast, LLC was retained to conduct the review
 - Opportunities were identified for coordination and communication improvement
- Occurs every two years and includes:
 - Change Management
 - Recommended Improvements
 - FERC Filings

Progress Made

- 3 Initial Recommendations
 - 2 complete
 - 1 ongoing
 - 2 new
 - Pseudo-Tie Coordination
 - Overlapping Congestion
- 3 Change Management Tickets implemented since last review
- 3 FERC Filings made & approved

- Ongoing
 - Documentation
 - Outage Coordination
- Upcoming
 - Pseudo-Tie Modeling
 - Freeze Date Solution
 - M2M Coordination Enhancements
