Issue Content

This work is intended to address a specific technical issue with the Firm Service Level (FSL) compliance construct for Demand Response and Price Responsive Demand. Sponsor is seeking to explore and potentially develop an optional, modified FSL compliance construct applicable to weather sensitive load which will enable greater participation by DR/PRD customers in the capacity market.

Key Work Activities and Scope

- 1. Review history and education on compliance constructs for DR and PRD
- 2. Discuss potential changes to compliance construct for weather sensitive load

Expected Deliverables

- 1. Potential changes to FSL compliance construct for DR and PRD to better accommodate weather sensitive loads
- 2. Potential manual and governing document changes
