


Consensus Packaged Solution is: 1B/2C/3A/4B/5D

Next Steps, Actions and Schedule 52 days remain until June 1

- April 16 Populate Matrix with Options/Package Options
- April 30 Decision Making Striving for Tier 1 solutions
- May 11 Decision Making Document consensus areas
- May 18 Draft Report Outline
 - Develop specific solution elements, recommendations and actions
- May 24 New Meeting Date: Complete Draft Report
- May 25 Safety Net Complete Report
 - Finalize NEMSTF recommendations, positions, advisories, next steps
- May 30 Clean-up final NEM Report
- June 1 Submit/Post NEMSTF report & recommendations
