Existing RTEP Process



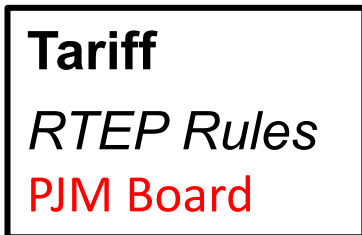
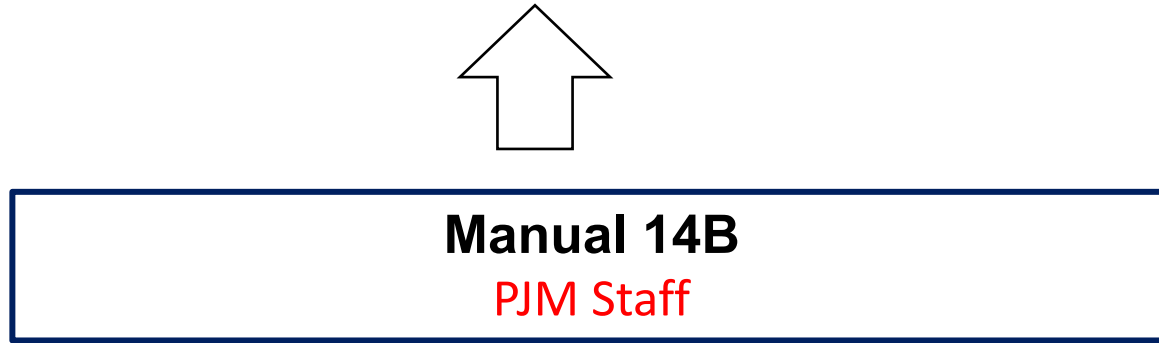

What else is in the amended Transmission Owners Agreement that affects regional transmission planning?

Sec. 4.1.4	Codifies that utility local planning supersedes PJM regional planning.
Secs. 7.3.1; 2.3; 6.3.8	Protects discussions between utilities and PJM about cost allocation with attorney client privilege. Establishes an annual closed-door meeting between the PJM Board and utilities. Requires PJM staff to discuss regional planning, cost allocation, or other matters at closed-door TO-AC meetings.
6.3.5	Deletes PJM's obligation to maintain its status a FERC-recognized RTO and replaces it with a requirement that it maintain RTO status only if consistent with the Transmission Owners Agreement.
6.3.11	Prevents PJM from filing at FERC any tariff changes that are "inconsistent with this Agreement."
9.16	Applies Mobile-Sierra protection to the Agreement (making it harder for FERC to order changes).
