

MVAR Default Email Notification Functionality

- Transmission users can view D-Curves and New Default MVAR Tickets on approved units from either the Transmission Tickets (Trans RW and R/O users) or Generator Data (Trans Planning users) menu.
- Transmission Planning users also desired email notification when New Default D-Curve Tickets have been approved and implemented.



The following new D-Curve defaults have been set for UNIT1
The ticket # 312642 for this change is in the status of Received.

- Companies will need to come up with the following:
 - Group email address (one per company) for email notification to be sent to those in email group managed by company.
 - Company password to open notification email attachment (encrypted PDF) containing ticket information. Password must be known by all in email group.
- Company representative fills out eDART MVAR Default Email Notification Request Form and submits it to PJM for approval and processing.

- When a New Default MVAR Ticket changes to the status of Received or Active, a notification email is sent to the agreed upon company's email group access.
- PDF (Encrypted) Contents
 - eDART Generator Ticket Unit Name, PJM EMS Equipment Name, PSSE Name.
 - Ticket number and status.
 - D-Curve (MW Point, MVAR Min, MVAR Max)
