American Electric Power Service Corporation, on behalf of its affiliate, Appalachian Power Company (“Appalachian Power,” together, “AEP”), hereby submits for filing for informational purposes an Annual Update to Appalachian Power’s Capacity Compensation Formula Rate, which applies to the upcoming Rate Year. Consistent with the Capacity Compensation Formula Rate Implementation Protocols, Schedule 8.1 – Appendix 2A of the PJM Interconnection, L.L.C.
