Re: Retirement Notification for AES ES Tait, LLC Warrior Run Energy Storage Project
(AP WARRIOR RUN 2 BT)

To Whom it May Concern:

Pursuant to Section 113.1 of the PJM Open Access Transmission Tariff (“PJM Tariff”), and in accordance with Section 9 of PJM Manual 14D, AES ES Tait, LLC, hereby submits notice of its intent to retire the AES ES Tait, LLC Warrior Run Energy Storage Project (AP WARRIOR RUN 2 BT) unit (the “Facility”).

The Facility is a fifteen-minute energy storage system rated at approximately 5 MW. The Facility is directly and wholly owned by AES ES Tait, LLC, which is an indirect subsidiary of The AES Corporation.

AES ES Tait, LLC plans to retire the Facility by [October] 1, 2024 (the “Deactivation Date”), subject to any regulatory requirements and market conditions. The Facility will be retired. We understand the implications for grid reliability and commit to a smooth transition.

Please note that pursuant to Section 113.2 of the PJM Tariff and because this Notice was sent prior to June 30, 2024, by August 31, 2024, PJM is required to (1) notify AES ES Tait, LLC of any reliability impacts resulting from the proposed unit retirement specified herein and (2) provide an initial estimate of the period of time it will take to complete any transmission system reliability upgrades necessary to alleviate the reliability impacts. After receiving such notice and estimate, AES ES Tait, LLC will review whether to extend the Deactivation Date consistent with maintaining the transmission system reliability in accordance with the PJM Tariff.
